**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE POSITION OF STUDENT DEMONSTRATOR
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/27
ELTE FACULTY OF EDUCATION AND PSYCHOLOGY, DEPARTMENT OF AFFECTIVE PSYCHOLOGY**

Active students of ELTE PPK may apply (regardless of their study schedule) if they:

- Are interested in the scientific fields taught and researched by the Department,
- Are able to navigate their field and translate literature in a foreign language,
- Commit to performing demonstrator duties for up to 10 hours per week.

The demonstrator assignment is awarded through an application process. The appointment lasts for 2 semesters. The assignment can be won multiple times.

The title of Student Demonstrator is awarded by the Dean of ELTE PPK.

This is based on submitted applications and the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Affective Psychology.

In addition to the Head of Department, the instructor/researcher supporting the student's professional work will evaluate the student (by writing a teacher recommendation).

Specific duties are determined by the Head of Department and the supporting instructor. The demonstrator must prepare a progress report each semester.

Deadline for evaluating the applications: **October 2, 2026**

General duties of the demonstrator:

- Participation in institute/departmental scientific research;
- Participation in teaching activities (preparing classes taught by the center, holding lectures or leading seminars in their own topic);
- Involvement in various educational and research organization tasks (e.g., organizing practical classes, conferences, preparing applications, managing professional events, etc.);
- Participation in research group administrative tasks;
- Contribution to communication between the center and students, and to the work of the student circle;
- Reporting on their work publicly before the center at specified intervals (each semester).

The demonstrator may participate in department meetings with advisory capacity, join research work conducted by departmental instructors, and attend professional programs.

The application must include:

1. **Application form** (downloadable form)
2. **Letter of motivation**
3. **Professional CV**
4. **Instructor/Researcher recommendation** (exact details are listed below)

The Head of Department will only evaluate the application and make a proposal if a signed recommendation from an instructor/researcher is attached.

The signed recommendation—or an email sent from the instructor's/researcher's university email address explicitly supporting the student's demonstrator activity—must be attached by the student. If this is not possible, the institute secretariat will obtain it from the designated instructor/researcher after submission, by September 18, 2026, at the latest.

If the recommendation cannot be obtained, the institute/department secretariat will immediately notify the student that the application will not be forwarded to the Dean, as the application cannot be supported without this recommendation.
