



DEMONSTRATOR APPLICATION FOR THE 2026/27 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Department of Counselling Psychology and Therapeutic Interventions at the Institute of Psychology, Faculty of Education and Psychology (PPK), Eötvös Loránd University (ELTE), invites applications for the position of DEMONSTRATOR for the 2026/27 academic year.

Eligibility criteria:

Any full-time student at ELTE PPK studying pedagogy or psychology, or at another ELTE faculty, who:

- Has achieved outstanding academic results,
- Is interested in psychological consultation, counseling, prevention, crisis intervention, therapeutic interventions, and applied psychological research,
- Is able to work with academic content in English, translating academic literature, and communicating both orally and in writing in English.
- Willing to participate in educational, research, and departmental community activities,
- Experience gained through previous research, in a related professional field, through fieldwork, or through volunteer or student organizational activities is also an advantage.

Responsibilities of the demonstrator:

- **Research assistant duties:** active participation in the work of the department's faculty members, researchers, research groups, and Ph.D. students. Tasks may include searching for and summarizing academic literature, identifying measurement tools, preparing them for translation or adaptation, editing research materials, participating in data collection, assisting with the preparation of interview- or questionnaire-based research, and organizing qualitative and quantitative research materials.
- **Connection to the department's research topics:** Demonstrators may participate in, among other things, psychological counseling, consultation processes, therapeutic interventions, prevention, crisis, trauma, addictive behaviors, life management difficulties, mental health, well-being, helping relationships, qualitative psychological research, criminal psychology, and human science psychology.
- **Education-related activities:** assisting with the preparation and updating of educational materials, compiling reading lists, supporting student communication, performing organizational tasks related to courses, and participating in student mentoring within the framework of courses and training programs offered by the department.

- **Organizing departmental programs and professional events:** participating in the preparation and execution of departmental workshops, professional events, open houses, conferences, informal community events, and student programs.
- **Communication and Social Media:** promoting the department's professional visibility, creating content for the department's social media platforms, assisting with event communications, and preparing news articles, reports, interviews, or short professional pieces.
- **Independent research:** Based on their own interests and with the support of their advisor, demonstrators may also conduct independent research related to the topics pursued by the department's faculty, researchers, or research groups.

Working as a demonstrator gives students the opportunity to gain a closer understanding of the department's educational, research, and professional activities, to become involved in the work of a professional community focused on applied psychology, and to gain experience in the areas of research, teaching, and organizational tasks.

- **Note:**
The position itself is unpaid. However, in the 2026/27 Autumn semester, the demonstrator may apply for a scholarship to the Student Union (HÖK).
