**Preliminary guide for international students
at Eötvös Loránd University (ELTE), Budapest, Hungary**

Dear Student,

Please read the following information carefully to check what you need to arrange right after you arrive at ELTE. We know it's a bit long, but it is very important that you don't miss anything you need to arrange in order to have a smooth beginning.

We would like you to give us [feedback on your arrival](#) as in No. 2 below.



TO-DO'S RIGHT AFTER YOU ARRIVE AT ELTE (AUG-SEPT 2026):

- ✓ Meet your mentor
- ✓ Enrolment (don't forget to bring the necessary original, physical documents!)
- ✓ Register for your courses in the Neptun system
- ✓ Get your residence permit card
- ✓ Request a student ID
- ✓ Request your health insurance: UNION and TAJ
- ✓ Prepare everything to receive your monthly scholarship (including opening a bank account and acquiring a tax ID)
- ✓ Attend the Welcome Week's programmes
- ✓ Read more information: University life

HOW TO DO IT

1. Meet your mentor (optional)

If you have requested a mentor, keep in touch with them and let them know about your arrival. You can arrange to meet as soon as you've arrived. They will show you around the city or can help you with any arrangements if necessary.

2. Enrolment

Time and location for enrolment and registration:

**26, 27, 28, 29, 31 August and 1 September,
no. 23-27, Kazinczy street, Budapest**

Remember to check the necessary documents to bring along for enrolment on our website, [here](#).

If you cannot enrol at the given time but arrive later **due to visa issues**, please inform our [Registrar's Office](#), so that they can prepare for your late enrolment. Activating your semester in Neptun is still a must even in this case until Sept 6!



Please give us **informal feedback** [on this questionnaire](#) by **Friday morning** (28 August) about your **expected arrival** so that we can plan further enrolment and the events of the faculty welcome accordingly. 

3. Semester activation and course registration

- **Activate your semester** until **6 September, 20:00** the latest
- Don't forget to register for your courses! Even if you arrive late, registering for your courses by the deadline is still a must. Also, please consider notifying your teachers about your delay so that they won't expect you at the first class.
- We've attached a PDF that summarises the deadlines and the most important things to know about the course registration period.

4. Get your residence permit card (for non-EEA students)

If you travel to Hungary with a D-visa and/or applied for a residence permit outside of Hungary, at a Hungarian consulate or embassy, your residence permit is prepared by the immigration office and when ready it will be sent to the university. Quaestura Office will send you a Neptun message and/or email once you can go and collect your residence permit from them. Their message will include the exact address as well.

If you come from a visa-waiver country and travelled to Hungary with your passport, you need to apply for a residence permit for the purpose of studies after your arrival. You can apply online, on the Enter Hungary website: <https://enterhungary.gov.hu/eh/?en>. After you submit all the necessary documents on the website, you have 15 days to visit the office of the National Directorate-General for Aliens Policing personally. The processing of your case begins when you appear in person in the office.

5. Request a student ID / Student card

After your arrival and enrolment at the faculty, you must obtain a student ID/card at ELTE.

- First you need a NEK ID which you can arrange at a “Kormányablak” (integrated government customer service) in Budapest (your mentor can help you with this). After taking your photo, you will be registered and given a NEK ID.
- Then you have to upload this NEK ID number into the Neptun system.
- Finally, you will proceed at [Quaestura Office](#) to finalise the procedure and request a Student ID.

You will receive a temporary paper student ID, and later you will receive the regular plastic student card. Please note that you can only request the temporary paper student ID starting from the beginning of the study period, so from 7 September 2026.

Please keep your passport and other personnel documents with you when arranging your student ID.

6. Request your health insurance

Stipendium Hungaricum students are eligible for health care services in Hungary through both UNION (a private health insurance provider) and also the “TAJ card”, which is public Social Security in Hungary.

To obtain your UNION health insurance: You can also sign up through the Quaestura Office, you will be notified of the details around the beginning of September.

7. Prepare everything to receive your monthly scholarship

- **Open a Hungarian bank account**

Open a Hungarian bank account and add the account number to the Neptun system (*Finances/Data and settings*). Please ask your mentor for help if you need assistance with opening a bank account. Your scholarship cannot be paid to a foreign or virtual bank account.

- **Request a Tax Identification Number and Card**

The National Tax and Customs Administration issues the Tax Identification Number and Card. The first application for a Tax Card is free of charge. You can visit their office in person, where you will receive your Tax Number on the spot, which you will need to upload to the Neptun system (actually, it is only the Registrar’s Office that can upload your tax no. in the system so you need to present it to them when you have it). You will receive a Tax Card by post later.

Ask your mentor if you need support in getting the tax ID no. and card.

Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship payments will be transferred to your Hungarian bank account monthly via the Neptun study system. Please note that except your first scholarship, your following SH allowances can only be transferred to you after you have signed your scholarship contract at the faculty

Registrar's Office, arranged all the above, and everything (bank account, tax ID, Hungarian permanent address) is registered in the Neptun system. The bank account no. is a must even to your first transfer!
