Basics of Tourism, Sport and Health Tourism (3 ECTS)

Oktatás célja

Aim of the subject

Main goal of this subject is getting to know the core characteristics of operating in tourism. It is helpful for the future sport and recreation organizers since tourism sphere could be a potential job opportunity for them.

In this course the basics of tourism, such as the operation of accommodation industry is toned, because it is the most important element of the tourism system, in the view of the recreational activities. In the second part of the semester the focus is on the trends, theory and practice in active, sports and health tourism, based on the ground tourism studies.

- He/She knows the main definitions of tourism, and its development.
- He/She knows and construe the tourism system, characteristics of demand and supply.
- He/She knows the most important (Hungarian) attractions, as the potential spots and venues of sports and health tourism areas.
- He/She can realize the characteristics of the accommodation units, related to the sport events and health tourism attractions.
- He/She knows the different scopes of activities in a hotel. Wellness and therapy department is toned in the education. Besides the personal conditions he/she knows the fundamental physical evidence of a hotel (objective conditions): parts of a hotel, rooms and assets).
- He/She knows the main used international hotel terms in English and in Hungarian.
- He/She knows the basics of the hospitality and travel industry, too.
- He/She knows and construe the system and the subareas of active tourism, characteristics of demand and supply.
- He/She knows and construe the market of professional and leisure sports tourism.
- He/She knows the market of health tourism.
- He/She can realize the most known and well-spread wellness tourism products and trends.

Attitude

- He/She is open-minded in the area of cognition and gaining professional experience.
- He/She tries after meet, introduce and apply new activities into the subareas of recreational and sports tourism.
- He/She considers important the thorough preparation, planning and flexible realization of activities in the recreational and sports tourism.

Abilities

- He/She can analyze the sports and health tourism system.
- He/She can plan active and sports tourism products.
- He/She can take part in operation of tourism-related firms specialized on health and sports.
